Yasmin Fahimi has been an employee representative on the Supervisory Board of Telefónica Deutschland Holding AG since May 2023.

Since 9 May 2022, Yasmin Fahimi has been Chairwoman of the German Trade Union Confederation and since October 2022, she has been a member of the Supervisory Board of Bayer AG.

After completing her studies, Yasmin Fahimi worked as a research assistant at the Foundation for Work and the Environment. From 2000 to 2013, she worked as a trade union secretary at the Mining, Chemical and Energy Industrial Union (IG BCE) in Hannover - first for the executive board and later as department head.

In 2014, she was elected general secretary of the Social Democratic Party of Germany (SPD). Two years later, she moved to the Federal Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs as State Secretary, where she was responsible in particular for pensions, labor law and international affairs until 2017.

In October 2017, Yasmin Fahimi was elected to the Bundestag for the first time as a directly elected member of parliament. During the legislative term, she was a member and chairwoman of the SPD parliamentary group in the Commission of Inquiry "Vocational Training in the Digital World of Work."

In September 2021, Yasmin Fahimi was again directly elected to parliament and was a full member of the Committee for Labor and Social Affairs. She is a member of the SPD party executive committee since December 2021.

After graduating from high school, she studied chemistry at Leibniz University in Hannover and graduated in 1998 with a degree in chemistry.
