O₂ is launching the Internet-Pack-Spezial to complement its existing Internet-Pack-L, which is suitable for high data use via a mobile Internet connection. For 25 Euros a month, the flat rate includes five gigabytes of data volume at top speed and also has a contract period of six months. It does not matter what offering the customers go for, with O₂ they surf in one of Europe's most advanced mobile networks. As per the last network test of Connect O₂ received outstanding evaluations and came second place.
